DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

EQUIPMENT SANITIZATION: Remove gross food and soil by scraping, presoaking or spraying. Wash equipment thoroughly with a cold or lukewarm solution of 1 ounce DINE-O-MITE to 5 gallons water. Rinse with potable water. Sanitize equipment by spraying or immersing for 2 minutes in a fresh solution of 1 ounce DINE-O-MITE to 5 gallons of cold or lukewarm water (provides 25 ppm titratable iodine). Drain the sanitizing solution from the surfaces and air dry. Do not rinse with potable water. Do not reuse sanitizing solution. Discard after use.

TANK AND VAT SANITIZATION: Pre-rinse or scrape gross soil particles. Preclean with 1 ounce DINE-O-MITE to 5 gallons of water (not hot). Rinse with potable water. To sanitize spray, immerse or circulate with 2 ounces DINE-O-MITE to 10 gallons water (provides 25 ppm titratable iodine). After 5 minutes, drain the sanitizing solution from the surfaces and allow to air dry. Do not rinse with potable water. Do not reuse sanitizing solution. Discard after use.

SANITIZATION OF WALLS, FLOORS AND CONVEYORS: Preclean surfaces to be sanitized with a compatible detergent and follow with a potable water rinse before application of the sanitizing solution. Sanitize daily by mopping, spraying or wiping surfaces with a solution of 2 ounces DINE-O-MITE to 10 gallons water (25 ppm titratable iodine). Allow solution to remain on surface for 2 minutes, drain and air dry. Do not rinse with potable water. Sanitize weekly or at the end of a batch run by mopping, spraying or wiping with a solution of 4 ounces DINE-O-MITE to 10 gallons of water (50 ppm titratable iodine). Allow sanitizing solution to remain on the surfaces for at least 2 minutes, drain and air dry. Do not rinse with potable water. Do not reuse sanitizing solution. Discard after use.

SANITIZING OF BEVERAGE CONTAINERS: To sanitize previously cleaned beverage containers which were first washed in a compatible cleaner and rinsed, fill container with a sanitizing solution containing 1 ounce DINE-O-MITE to 10 gallons of water (provides 12 1/2 ppm titratable iodine). Allow sanitizing solution to remain on surfaces for at least 2 minutes, invert container, drain and allow to air dry. Do not rinse with potable water. Do not reuse sanitizing solution. Discard after use.

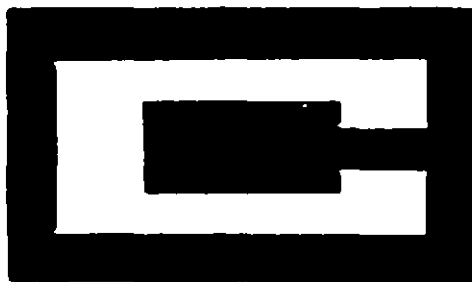
