## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**GLB BRAND LIQUID ALGICIDE** is designed for the control of algae found in most swimming pools. **USE ONLY ACCORDING TO DIRECTIONS GIVEN BELOW.**

### HOW MUCH TO USE

- 1. MAINTENANCE DOSAGE:** To maintain pool water free of visible algae, add 3/4 to 1.5 oz. of **GLB BRAND LIQUID ALGICIDE** per 1,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days.
- FOR POOLS WHICH HAVE JUST BEEN FILLED:** add an initial dose of 2 to 4 oz. of **GLB BRAND LIQUID ALGICIDE** per 1,000 gallons of water, then follow **MAINTENANCE DOSAGE** directions.
- FOR POOL WATER WITH VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH:** add an initial dose of 3.75 to 6 oz. of **GLB BRAND LIQUID ALGICIDE** per 1,000 gallons of water. Remove dead algae and debris by cleaning, then follow **MAINTENANCE DOSAGE** directions.

### METHOD OF APPLICATION:

1. Add required dose of **GLB BRAND LIQUID ALGICIDE** to a bucket of water or sprinkling can and distribute the mixture uniformly throughout the pool water to insure uniform distribution.
2. Do not mix concentrated **GLB BRAND LIQUID ALGICIDE** with any other concentrated chemicals—dry or liquid.

**GLB BRAND LIQUID ALGICIDE** is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH.

**GLB BRAND LIQUID ALGICIDE** can be used in pools treated with chlorine disinfectants and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required.
