The following amendments, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, are acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- Addition of optional marketing statements

Conditions:

1. You must include an Environmental Hazards statement. You must add the following text beneath the "precautionary Statements" heading:

Environmental Hazard: This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms."

{For containers of 5 gallons or more}

Environmental Hazard: This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, ponds, streams, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or regional Office of the EPA."

2. The Precautionary Statements must be revised to include the following two statements: "Wash with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, using tobacco." "Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

This product is a clear solution of bromide salts which remain as a stable bank in the spa or hot tub water until [brand name of product-activator] is added. This product has no disinfectant properties and it is only when [brand name] is added that bromine is released in water containing this product.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product should be added when the spa/hot tub is filled and weekly thereafter to maintain a bank of bromine in the water.

First, treat the spa/hot tub with [Insert product name of stain and scale preventer] according to its labeling directions. Then, add 4 ounces of this product per every 250 gallons of water directly into the spa or hot tub. Circulate the water while adding this product to ensure thorough distribution.

For weekly maintenance, add one ounce of this product per every 250 gallons of water to maintain a sufficient bank of bromine in the water.
