

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Hot Water Algicide is used to control algae growth in exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For effectiveness in hot tubs and whirlpools, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned with Hot Water Algicide.

Spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs having heavy algae growth require an initial dose of 8 to 10 fluid ounces of Hot Water Algicide per 1000 gallons of water. After treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled hot tub, add initially 4 to 8 fluid ounces of Hot Water Algicide per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent treatments should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

Hot Water Algicide is compatible with chlorine. It is normally used to treat spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. It is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Hot Water Algicide can be used in spas treated with chlorine. However, reduce the amount of those chemicals. However, do not mix Hot Water Algicide with liquid chlorine products.

INERT INGREDIENT 90.0 %

This product contains 0.85 lb. of active ingredient per gallon and weighs 8.49 lb. per gallon.
