DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algicide 30 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Algicide 30.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of Algicide 30 per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a pool with heavy algae growth, first remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of Algicide 30 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4 fluid ounces of Algicide 30 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains have a minimum effectiveness pool, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Algicide 30. require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of Algicide 30 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of Algicide 30 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of Algicide 30 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. Algicide 30 is compatible with other chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of other chlorine chemicals. However, do not mix Algicide 30 with other liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded with clear water. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children and away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container in plastic and discard.
