Algicide 40 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and indoor effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs. Heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 10 fluid ounces of Algicide 40 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of Algicide 40 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of Algicide 40 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of Algicide 40 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.
