BACK PANEL

FORCE 10 is a non-metallic, non-foaming concentrated algicide that will provide algae control when used as directed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CONTROL OR INHIBIT THE GROWTH OF SWIMMING POOL ALGAE:

Initial Dose:

Add $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon of Force 10 per 25,000 gallons of water.

Maintenance Dose:

Add 1 pint of Force 10 weekly per 25,000 gallons to provide continuous protection.

IF VISIBLE ALGAE IS PRESENT:

Treat with $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon of Force 10 per each 25,000 gallons of pool water. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove settled algae debris. Repeat treatment if necessary.

TO CLOSE POOL AT THE END OF THE SEASON:

Add $\frac{1}{2}$ gallon of Force 10 per 25,000 gallons of water to help control or inhibit the growth of swimming pool algae during winter months.

When Force 10 is used as directed, it will kill and prevent control or inhibit the growth of swimming pool algae. Force 10 at use dilution is non-corrosive to inanimate surfaces.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER - CORROSIVE

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed. If persistent, convulsions may be controlled by the cautious intravenous injections of a shortacting barbituate drug.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. 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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
