4. Revise the Environmental Hazards to read as follows:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge.

Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA".

5. Include the following re-entry statement: "Reentry into treated swimming pools is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm of chlorine".

A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

Submit one copy of the final printed labeling before releasing the product in channels of trade with the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

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ISOCYANURATE RED ATTACHMENT A - BATCH 31

LABELING: (Statements are based on review of referenced acute toxicity data)

1. The signal word is "DANGER"
2. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

3. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably, mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

- Adjust pool water pH to between 7.2 and 7.8 and total alkalinity to between 80 and 150 ppm as determined by a suitable test kit.
- Stabilize pool water with 40 ppm Conditioner as directed on the container label.
- Shock treat the pool water using Quick Shock Tablets or Oxy-Pure. Follow the label directions. Before using the pool, be certain the chlorine level returns to 1.0-1.5 ppm.

FOR USE IN AQUASAN OR E-Z CLOR FEEDER

- Punch all indentations on the bottom of the cartridge (or cut off the three water vent areas that stick out on the sides near the bottom of the cartridge). Two cartridges may be needed in a pool 30,000 gallons or larger.
- Do not cut off the air vent at the top of the cartridge.
- Make sure that the screw lid is on tight.
- Punch a hole through the lowest indentation on each side of the cartridge.
- Insert cartridge into feeder. If more chlorination is needed, punch more holes on each side of the cartridge starting at the lowest indentation and working up until the free available chlorine residual remains within the range of 1-1.5 ppm.

FOR USE IN GUARDEX FEEDER

- Cut off the air vent that sticks out near the top of the cartridge.
- Cut off the three water vent areas that stick out on the sides near the bottom of the cartridge. Two cartridges may be needed in a pool 30,000 gallons or larger.
- Insert the cartridge in the feeder, adjusting the cartridge height until the free available chlorine level in the pool remains within the range of 1-1.5 ppm.
