PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Strong Oxidizing Agent. Mix only with water. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water, if necessary.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Note to physician: Probably mucosal damage contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

1. Adjust the spa/hot tub water pH value to between 7.2 and 7.8.
2. Turn off all spa/hot tub equipment.
3. For shock treatment, measure out 0.5 ounce (2½ teaspoons) of Chlorinating Concentrate Granular per 500 gallons of spa water. For regular chlorination, measure out 0.1 ounce (1½ teaspoon) per 500 gallons of spa water. Dissolve the required dosage in a pail of water.
4. Add the dissolved Chlorinating Concentrate Granular to the spa or hot spa.
5. Turn on the air blower ONLY, for 3 minutes to mix the Chlorinating Concentrate Granular
6. After mixing, turn on the filtration system for 1 - 2 hours.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all materials before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container but container be place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal, or cleaning of equipment.
