DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a

1. INITIAL TREATMENT FOR PREVENTION OF ALGAE IN POOL WATER: Use 8 to 12 oz. of ALGIMYCIN "2000" per 10,000 gal. of water.
2. INITIAL TREATMENT FOR POOLS WITH ALGAE: Use 16 to 24 oz. of ALGIMYCIN "2000" per 10,000 gal. of water. Remove dead settled algae by vacuuming.
3. BLACK ALGAE CONTROL: Apply 16 fl. oz. of ALGIMYCIN "2000" per 10,000 gal. when algae first appears. Brush spots daily until algae is gone.
4. TO MAINTAIN POOLS FREE OF VISIBLY ALGAE: Apply 8 to 12 oz. of ALGIMYCIN "2000" per 10,000 gal. of water.

METHOD OF APPLICATION:

Never mix concentrated ALGIMYCIN "2000" with other pool chemicals as liquid or dry chlorine, acid or alkali. When used with other pool chemicals, ALGIMYCIN "2000" is compatible with those chemicals.

1. SHAKE WELL before measuring out required amount.
2. Mix required amount into bucket of water.
3. Distribute the mixture uniformly throughout pool by hand, pump, or wind-carried spray.
