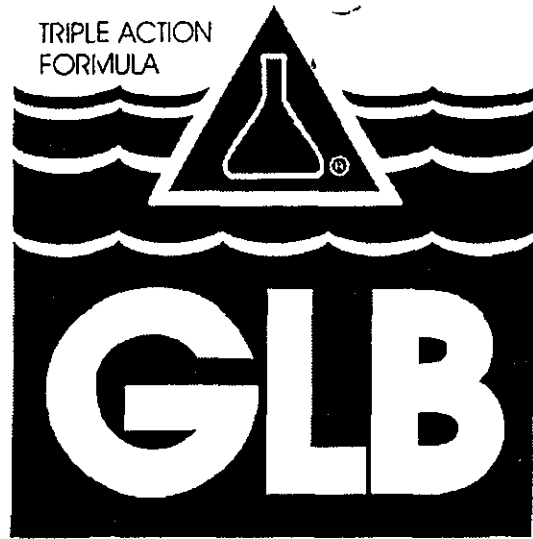

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. INITIAL TREATMENT FOR PREVENTION OF ALGAE GROWTH IN CLEAR POOL WATER: Use 8 to 12 oz. of ALGIMYCIN® "2000" for every 10,000 gallons of water.
2. INITIAL TREATMENT FOR POOLS WITH VISIBLE ESTABLISHED ALGAE: Use 16 to 24 oz. of ALGIMYCIN "2000" for every 10,000 gallons of water. Remove dead, settled algae by vacuuming.
3. BLACK ALGAE CONTROL: Apply 16 fl. oz. for every 10,000 gallons of water when algae first appears. Brush spots daily to remove dead algae. Vacuum out settled algae.
4. TO MAINTAIN POOLS FREE OF VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH: Use 4 to 8 fl. oz. of ALGIMYCIN "2000" per 10,000 gallons of water weekly.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

Never mix concentrated ALGIMYCIN "2000" with other concentrated pool chemicals such as liquid or dry chlorine, acid or alkali. When properly diluted in the pool, however, ALGIMYCIN "2000" is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools.

1. SHAKE WELL before measuring out required amount of ALGIMYCIN "2000."
2. Mix required amount into bucket of water or sprinkling can.
