Dear Ms. Radtke:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is not acceptable due to the deficiencies listed below.

Proposed Amendment

- Revisions to comply with changes required in PR Notice 2007-4;
- Addition of optional advisory statements;
- Addition of optional marketing statements;
- Addition of "Responsible Care" symbol" as advisory statement.

Revise the label as follows:

1.) In the Directions for Use

- A.) Add the following to Method of Application: "4. Repeat treatment until control is evident."
- B.) Revise your label to define "ample time" in "Method of Application."

2.) Revise the Precautionary Statements to read exactly as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using toilet. Avoid breathing vapor. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

3.) Revise the Storage and Disposal statement on label:

Delete "Rinse empty container thoroughly with water prior to disposal."
Replace with "Securely wrap original container in several layers of news paper and discard in trash." Or refer to the Label Review Manual Chapter 13 for alternative statements.

General Comments

Submit five copies of the revised labeling to the Agency for review.

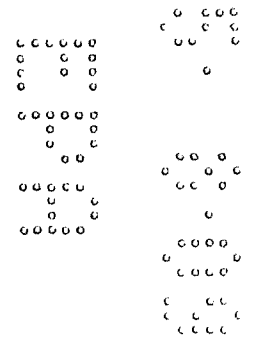
