Dear Ms. Carlisle,

Attached is a notification to submit the changes required in the comments paragraph of the label returned as not acceptable for the referenced product. We have revised the language in the Directions for Use and the Precautionary Statements as required. The comments also required us to delete parts of the Storage and Disposal language we had submitted and replace it with a statement to "Wrap container and put in trash..". In reviewing the changes and options available I found that in PR Notice 2007-1 the Wrap container language was no longer allowed. I called and talked to Tracy Lantz and it was decided to keep the language that was on the label, that being the language required in PR Notice 2007-4.

We would therefore ask that you accept the Nonrefillable container – household/residential use language as appears on our originally submitted label to satisfy the conditions of registration. In support of this notification enclosed you will find the following:


