SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

DOSAGE RATES:

Solid-Coverd Pools: 1/2 gallon WINTERTRINE per 20,000 gallons of pool water.
 Mesh-Covered or Uncovered Pools: 1 gallon WINTERTRINE per 20,000 gallons of pool water

APPLICATION:

Shake the container well and pour the proper amount of WINTERTRINE around the entire pool perimeter. Continue circulation of pool water for 6 hours to ensure proper distribution of WINTERTRINE.

INITIAL POOL STARTUP:

In spring, WINTERTRINE winterized pools should be cleaned and vacuumed. Start your algae-free swimming season by using SWIMTRINE PLUS as part of your regular swimming season maintenance program.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Wintertrine is compatible with other pool treatment chemicals. Compatible with all sanitizers including bromine, chlorine, salt water, ozone and minerals.

TO ESTIMATE POOL CAPACITY

Square or Rectangular Pools - L x W x D x 7.5 = Gallons
 Circular or elliptical Pools - L x W x D x 5.9 = Gallons

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
