- 2) Revise the last statement under the "Precautionary Statements" to reflect the current language from the Label Manual by stating "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling *and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.*"



**FIRST AID:**

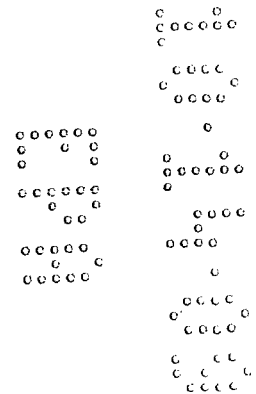
