The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Shake the container well and pour the proper amount of this product around the entire pool perimeter. Continue circulation of pool water for 6 hours to ensure proper distribution of this product.

INITIAL POOL STARTUP:

In spring, [this product] winterized pools must be cleaned and vacuumed. Start your algae-free swimming season by using [product name] as part of your regular swimming season maintenance program.
