


DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL, ACETATE OR SPANDEX USE FOR WHITE AND FAST COLORS ONLY

- LAUNDRY Add ¹/₈ cup of FS Bleach per each 2 gallons of water. Boiling is unnecessary. Mix well. Wash in usual way. As a bleach add $\frac{1}{8}$ cup or 1 oz. per 2 gallons of water or one cup bleach per each washing machine load (16 gallon machine). Rinse in several waters before drying. In automatics bleach should be added to suds water before clothing is placed in machine. If added while clothing is in suds, dilute with 1 quart water before adding.
- STAIN REMOVER To remove scorch, ink, tea, coffee, grass, or other stains, add 1/4 cup of FS Bleach to quart of water. Mix well and allow to soak 5-10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly. Repeat if necessary. Colored fabrics - test small piece before using.
- WOODWORK, BASINS, SINKS, REFRIGERATORS, STOVES, TILE, DRAINBOARDS -Wash. Then wet with solution of 3/4 cup FS Bleach per gallon warm water. Rinse. (Do not use on steel, aluminum, silver, or chipped enamel.)
- GLASSWARE, DISHES, WOODEN UTENSILS Wash. Then soak 2 minutes in solution of one tablespoon FS Bleach per gallon of water. (Do not use on silverware.) This dilution gives 210 parts per million available chlorine.
- **TOILET BOWLS** Clean and flush. Pour in $\frac{1}{2}$ cup FS Bleach, swab, let stand for 10 minutes, and flush. Do not mix with any other chemicals.
- GARBAGE CANS Wash with hot sudsy water. Rinse. Pour in 3/4 cup FS Bleach per gallon of water and swab inside. Let stand 5 minutes. Rinse.
- FLOORS Scrub with mixture of 3/4 cup FS Bleach per gallon of sudsy water. (Do not use on cork or linoleum.)
- CAUTION: HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED! If FS Bleach is swallowed feed milk, egg whites, or large quantity of water. If splashed in eyes, flood immediately with water. Call a doctor right away in either case. Do not use with ammonia, bowl cleaners, or other household chemicals. Use in porcelain, glass, rubber, plastic or enamel only, not copper, aluminum or iron.


