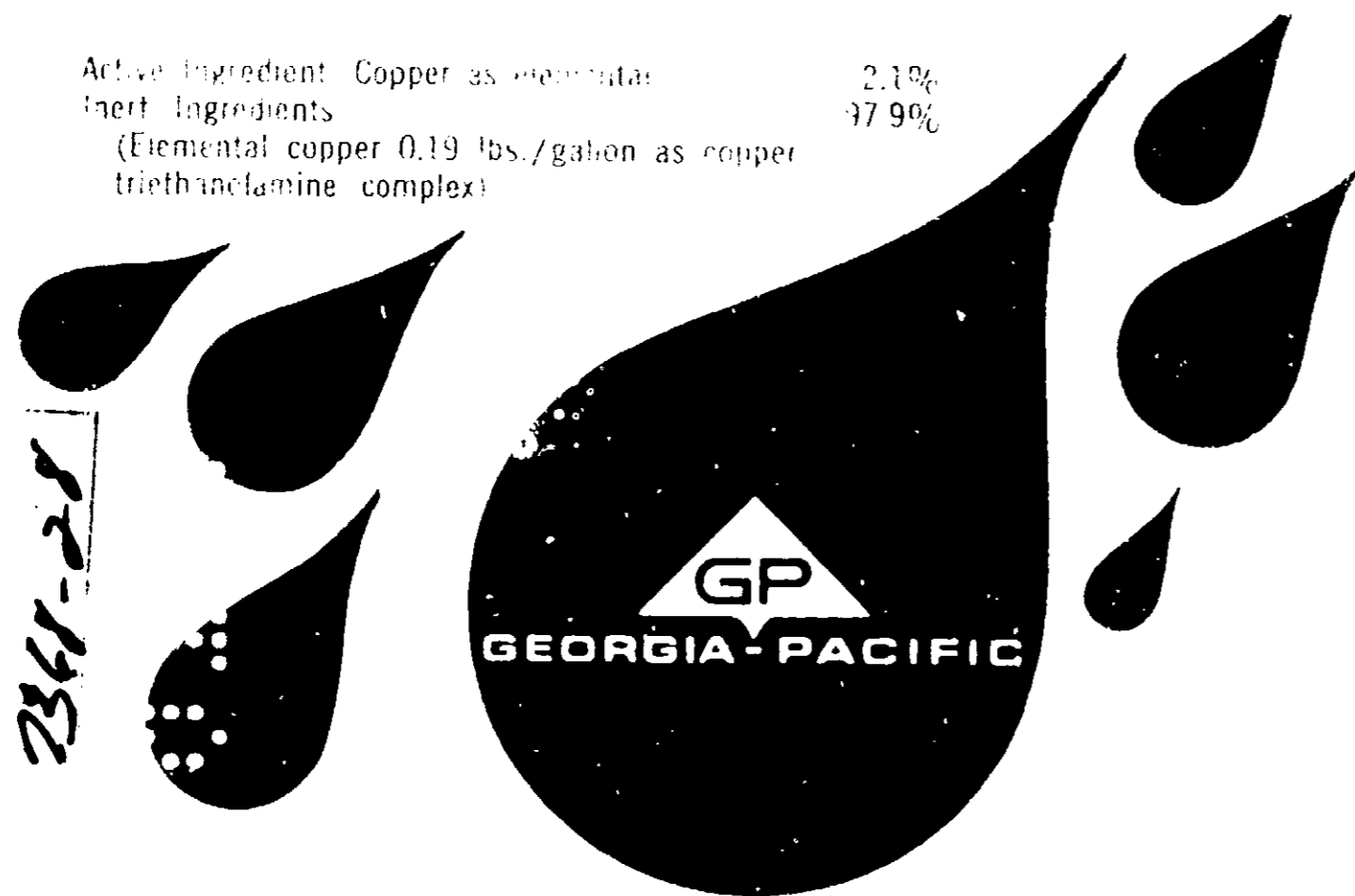

This formula is absolute, non-foaming and requires maintenance dose only once each two (2) week

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. CHLORINATE to maintain 1.0-1.5 residual chlorine as determined with reliable test kit.
2. ADJUST pH to 7.2-7.8 by adding G.P. Dry Acid or G.P. Soda Ash as needed.
3. ADD G.P. Algae Control II to deep end at the rate of 16 fl. oz. per 10,000 gallons pool water.
4. FILTER continuously for 24 hours.
5. REMOVE dead algae the following day by brushing and vacuuming, as necessary.
6. REPEAT addition of G.P. Algae Control II at rate of 8 fl. oz. per 10,000 gallons immediately after vacuuming the dead algae and each 14 days as maintenance dose. Also repeat steps 1 and 2.
