### BABBITT INSTITUTIONAL INSECT KILLER

#### CAUTIONS

CAUTION: Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in food processing areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish bowls during treatment. Hold container at least 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics, furniture. Certain plastic materials and tiles, painted and varnished surfaces, and wallpaper may discolor, streak, and soften when wet with insecticides. Do not spray such materials.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**FLYING INSECTS:** Flies, mosquitos, gnats, wasps. Remove protective cap, hold container upright, aim away from you, push button and spray with circular motion up towards center of room. Fill the closed room with mist and leave it closed for 15 minutes after treatment. It is not essential to spray flying insects—airborne mist will kill insects as they fly through it. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

**CRAWLING INSECTS:** Roaches, ants, silverfish, spiders. Spray baseboards and other surfaces where these bugs crawl. (Note above caution for painted surfaces). Spray under sinks, behind appliances, under cabinets, in cracks and crevices, openings around plumbing and other places where these pests hide and breed. Spray ant hills and trails.
