#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

<b>STORAGE</b>	Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.
<b>DISPOSAL</b>	Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

**General:** Spray surface to wetting. Point spray away from people, plants and pets. Do not use as a space spray. Use only for spot treatment.

**To Kill Ants, Roaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders and Earwigs:** Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. Contact directly as many insects as possible. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as necessary for control.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Remove and destroy old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and floor areas of floor. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spray has dried. Do not spray animals with this product. Treat animals with appropriate flea and tick product.

**To Kill Carpet Beetles and Dermestids:** Spray along baseboards, edges of carpeting, under carpets and rugs, under furniture, in closets, on shelving, and in other places of harborage. Repeat as necessary.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush skin and eyes with plenty of water. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

#### CAUTION

##### KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

<b>IF IN EYES:</b>	Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
<b>IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:</b>	Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
<b>IF INHALED:</b>	Remove to fresh air. If effects occur, and call physician.
<b>IF SWALLOWED:</b>	Do not induce vomiting because of possible aspiration hazard. Get medical attention immediately.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Keep away from fire, sparks and heated surfaces. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Certain plastic materials, asphalt tiles, painted and varnished surfaces, wallpaper, fabrics and furniture may discolor, streak or soften when wet with insecticides. Do not spray such materials. Test on an inconspicuous area before using.
