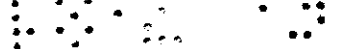

 GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Georgia-Pacific Spa Algaecide is used to control the growth of algae in exterior spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Georgia-Pacific Spa Algaecide.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 10 to 15 fluid ounces of Georgia-Pacific Spa Algaecide per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirlpool, or hot tub, add initially 7 to 10 fluid ounces of Georgia-Pacific Spa Algaecide per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 5 fluid ounces of Georgia-Pacific Spa Algaecide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Georgia-Pacific Spa Algaecide is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Georgia-Pacific Spa Algaecide can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Georgia-Pacific Spa Algaecide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep container closed when not in use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Rinsate that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Open dumping is prohibited.

- METAL CONTAINERS:** Triple rinse and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in an approved landfill or bury in a safe place.
- PLASTIC CONTAINERS:** Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse and incinerate or dispose of in an approved landfill or bury in safe place.
