DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use of this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling is a violation of Federal Law

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION: Aqua Chem[®] Algicide Liquid is an efficient and economical product for the reduction of green, blue-green and square D algae growths in pool water and on pool surfaces. It will not harm pool surfaces or equipment and is compatible with most other pool chemicals.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Do not allow swimming in pool for at least 15 minutes after Aqua Chem Algicide Liquid has been applied.
2. Always apply this and other pool treatment chemicals separately, never in combination.
3. Sunlight exposure, bather load and frequency of pool use all affect the rate at which unsanitary pool water conditions develop. Always adjust pool cleaning and maintenance functions and schedules according to your specific circumstances.

HOW TO USE AQUA CHEM ALGICIDE LIQUID

1. Before using any water treatment chemicals, check to ensure all pool equipment is working properly, including pump, filter, skimmer and heater.
2. Backwash filter, following normal procedure for your pool's filter.
3. Check water pH (acidity/alkalinity balance) with an Aqua Chem Test Kit, following label directions. Desired pH range is between 7.2-7.6. If necessary, adjust pH by adding Aqua Chem pH Decreaser to lower pH, or Aqua Chem pH Increaser to raise pH. Follow label directions for these products.
4. Recheck pH and maintain it between 7.2-7.6 for at least 6 hours before adding Aqua Chem Algicide Liquid.
5. To reduce algae growth, add Aqua Chem Algicide Liquid at a rate of 1 gallon per 10,000 gallons of water by pouring it into pool at deep end. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when using this product. Avoid contamination of clothing. See First Aid information elsewhere on this label.
6. Operate recirculating pump during addition of Aqua Chem Algicide Liquid and for 6 hours thereafter to ensure complete distribution in water.
7. If necessary, brush pool surfaces the following day to dislodge dead algae for removal by pool filter. Repeat dosage, if necessary, to remove additional algae spots.

8. To reduce further growth of algae and microorganisms, a regular maintenance application of algicide is recommended. Add Aqua Chem Algicide Liquid at a rate of 32 fluid ounces every 5-7 days, following directions above. If weather conditions or pool use frequency cause development of algae and microorganisms, adjust your treatment schedule accordingly.
9. A booster dose of 32 fluid ounces (1 quart) should be added after every rainfall.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing, mechanically may be needed.

DANGER: Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Irritates eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.
