PRODUCT DESCRIPTION: Aqua Chem Algaecide Liquid efficiently and economically reduces green, blue-green and square D algae growths in pools. It will not harm pool surfaces or equipment and is compatible with most other pool chemicals.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Do not allow swimming in pool for at least 15 minutes after Aqua Chem Algaecide Liquid has been applied.
2. Always apply this and other pool treatment chemicals separately, never combine them.
3. Slight rainfall, temperature, number of swimmers and the amount of pool use all affect the rate at which unsanitary pool water conditions develop. Adjust your pool cleaning and maintenance accordingly.
4. This product is not for human consumption and therefore should not be used for spa treatment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in any manner not consistent with its labeling.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

1. Make sure all pool equipment is working properly, including pump, filter, skimmer and heater.
2. Backwash filter, following normal procedure for your pool's filter.
3. Check water pH (acidity/alkalinity balance) with an Aqua Chem Test Kit, following label directions. Desired pH range is between 7.2-7.6. If necessary, adjust pH by adding Aqua Chem pH Decreaser to lower pH or Aqua Chem pH Add to raise pH. Follow label directions for these products.
4. Recheck pH and maintain it between 7.2-7.6 for at least 6 hours before adding Aqua Chem Algaecide.

NOW USE AQUA CHEM ALGAECIDE

1. Add 26 fl. oz. per 10,000 gallons of water by pouring it into deep end of pool. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves. Also avoid contamination of clothing. (See First Aid information elsewhere on this label.)
2. Operate recirculating pump while adding Aqua Chem Algaecide.

Liquid and for 6 hours afterward to ensure complete distribution in water.

3. If necessary the next day, brush dead algae off pool surfaces so it can be filtered away. Repeat dosage to remove additional algae spots.
4. To reduce future growth of algae and micro-organisms, a regular maintenance application of this algaecide is recommended. Add Aqua Chem Algaecide Liquid at a rate of 6 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water every 5-7 days, following directions above.
5. A booster dose of 6 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water should be added after every rainfall.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID):

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. **IF ON SKIN:** Immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. **IF SWALLOWED:** Promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water.
