

SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE SPRAYING. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

To KIN Files, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spraying 5 to 10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Vertilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and Jestroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utanslis.

To Kill Cockroachas. Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible directly with spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. For control of ants treat doors, window sills, and other areas of entry. Pepeat as necesary for control.

NOTE: When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients until after ventilation.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trasn collection.

CAUTION
