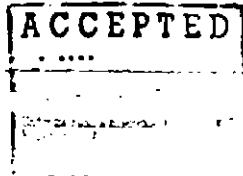

THIS CLOR has an available liquid sanitizer of 5% available chlorine and contains 1% available chlorine. For more information, contact your distributor.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Dilute this product in a normal concentration of 1:100.

PREPARE, CLEAN AND RINSE:

1. Prepare sanitizing solution.
2. Rinse with clean water.
3. Apply 500-1,000 ppm (100-200 mg/l) of available chlorine to the surface to be sanitized. Allow to remain for 10 minutes.
4. Rinse with clean water to dry.

GENERAL HOUSEhold USES:

1. Pre-rinse, pre-wash items to be washed.
2. Wash and rinse.
3. Sanitize in a 500-1,000 ppm (100-200 mg/l) of available chlorine solution.

NOTE: Sani-clor is a low-temperature liquid sanitizer and requires no heat. Use only with a chlorine test kit and adjust chlorine level as necessary to insure a minimum of 500 ppm available chlorine. Do not use on skin or other surfaces.

AVAILABLE CHLORINE/TABLET OF PROPORTIONS:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flush area with large quantities of water.
