This is in response to your request to amend the registration of the subject product to include labeling revisions.

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following labeling revisions before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Include the company's street address on the label.
 - b. On the front panel, relocate the signal word "DANGER" so that it appears immediately below "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN".
 - c. On the front panel, revise "May be harmful if swallowed" to read "May be fatal if swallowed". Note that this will make this statement consistent with the statement in the precautionary section of the labeling.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals
DANGER - CORROSIVE

Keep out of Reach of Children

MAY BE FATAL IF SWALLOWED. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear face shield or safety glasses and rubber gloves when handling. Wash with soap and water after handling.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARD

This product is a strong oxidizing agent and concentrate that must be diluted with water according to directions. Do not mix with other chemicals.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. Drink a teaspoon of milk of magnesia and lots of water.

If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Immediately seek medical attention.

If on skin: Wipe off acid gently. Wash with plenty of soap and water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of a gastric gavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Store in a cool dry place. Dispose by placing in a plastic bag and throwing in trash collection.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Removes lime, hard water deposits, uric acid salts, and various discolorations from toilet bowls, urinals, shower stalls, swimming pools, drinking fountains, wash basins and lavatories when used as directed. For use in industrial and institutional maintenance.

PORCELAIN AND OTHER SURFACES

To clean sinks, wash basins, shower stalls, drinking fountains, coffee urns, sterilizers, brass rails, ceramic tile floors, and other enameled and plated surfaces: Always dilute with 3 or 4 parts water. Apply with mop or sponge. Do not allow solution to remain on fixture without immediately thoroughly rinsing with water.

TOILET BOWLS AND URINALS

Flush and remove as much water as possible by "plunging". Apply with yarn mop and allow to remain on surfaces at least 10 minutes until all rust stains and scale are loosened. Clean upper part of bowl under flush rim and down into trap. To remove odor causing bacteria and incrustation in trap, pour 2 to 3 ounces into urinal and allow to remain as long as possible.

GROUT: For discoloration between wall tiles, heavy soap or lime removal - Use as is.
