Dear Mr. Meeker:

This is in regard to your proposed formulation change and revised label ingredients statement, re-submitted in response to the Agency letter dated April 28, 1994.

The revised formulation (as represented by your Confidential Statement of Formula dated May 10, 1994) and labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted before the product is released for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Under the heading "Storage and Disposal," add the text:

Store in a cool dry place, away from other chemicals. Do not reuse empty container. Dispose by rinsing empty bottle with water and put in trash collection.

2. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, in the "If swallowed" statement, in the second sentence ("Drink large quantities..."), delete the reference to milk, or else replace that sentence with the one that appears on your previous EPA-accepted label, "Drink a teaspoon of milk of magnesia and lots of water."

The new product name of record, "Skasol Scout 20 Porcelain, Tile & Bowl Cleaner," has been noted in our files.
