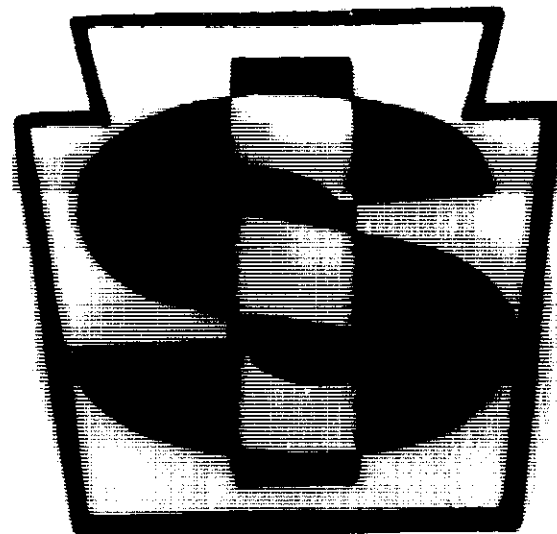

INSECT SPRAY

CAUTION Contents Under Pressure

Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

NET WEIGHT 1 LB.



1. For Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Hornets, spray room towards ceiling. Fill the room with mist or spray 2 to 5 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Close off room while spraying and for 10 to 15 minutes afterwards.
2. For Roaches and Silverfish. Spray into cracks around doors and floors.
3. For ants, spray ant trails, around window frames, door sills and wherever ants may enter.
4. For bedbugs, spray cushions, and mattresses, beds and baseboards.
5. Thoroughly spray floors and floor coverings, including the spraying of floors and bedding of animals' sleeping quarters. Replace treated bedding with fresh bedding.

Shake can thoroughly before using.

CAUTION

Do not spray on skin, or animals. Wash with soap and water after using. Avoid inhalation of mist. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove birds, pets, and fish bowls from rooms being sprayed. Do not store above 120 degrees Fahrenheit. Do not puncture or throw can in fire. Keep out of reach of children.
