Dear Folks:

I recommend this package of ferti-lome for controlling broadleaf and vining type weeds because I have found it most effective. I think you will find the following information complete and easy to follow.

1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

ferti-lome WEED AND FEED for controlling broadleaf and vining type weeds is for applying to your lawn when you want to give it a good feeding at the same time kill "broadleaf and vining" type weeds.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Apply uniformly using fertilizer spreader. Apply when grass is dry. Apply at the rate of 1 bag per 3000 sq. ft. See chart below for proper ferti-lome spreader setting to apply this product. Apply when weeds have appeared and before they reach maturity. Shut off spreader when stopping or turning around.

These settings can be used only as a guide, they are not absolute. The speed at which the applicator walks, the condition of the spreader, and the texture of the turf will alter the rate of fertilizer application.

Weed killing action is most effective when weeds are growing rapidly. This is normally during time of warm weather, adequate moisture and plant food. Treatment during dry ~~xxx~~ or cool weather usually reduces killing action.

New Lawns should be well established and mowed at least twice before treatment. This product controls clover. Do not use on lawns where clover is desired. Clean spreader thoroughly after using.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU CAN EXPECT!

ferti-lome WEED AND FEED for controlling broadleaf and vining type weeds applied according to directions will give you control of dandelions, chickweed, buck-horn, plantain, clovers, smart weed, wild carrot, mustard, ground ivy, English Daisy, Filago and other similar weeds and the ~~xxx~~ same time measurably improve your lawn due to the application of a plant food.

Plant Food and water are both necessary for proper turf management. However, quite often it has been found that lesser amounts of water are necessary to keep turf green and growing when the above feeding schedule is followed.
