For best results apply when temperature is 65°F or above. Apply one 40 lb bag per 3000 square feet of lawn area. Apply uniformly using fertilizer spreader. Apply when grass is dry and water in thoroughly. See Chart below for proper fertilome spreader setting to apply this product. Apply when weeds have appeared and before they reach maturity. Shut off spreader when stopping or turning around.
