

1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This new product kills borers in the trunks of fruit and nut trees wherever borer larvae are working underneath the bark.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

To kill Lesser Peach Tree Borers in Peach, Plum, Prune, Cherry and Almond trees mix 2½ table-spoons in 1 gallon of water. Spray trunk and lower branches. Repeat at three week intervals. Do not treat peach trees within 7 days of harvest, nor cherry, plum or prune trees within 3 days of harvest.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT!

This new product, when used according to directions, will greatly aid you in controlling borer problems thus permitting healthy, more vigorous growth of your fruit and nut trees.

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

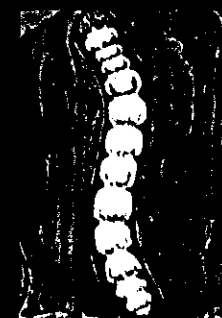
