The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following changes to your label:

a) In the USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS box, correct the spelling error "tiolet." Change "tiolet" to "toilet."

b) In the Directions for Use on the second page of your label, change "...avoid contact wit dusted surfaces" to "...avoid contact with dusted surfaces."

c) In the Directions for Use on OKRA, delete "5 to" from "Repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals."

d) In the Directions for Use on DOGS AND CATS, change the sentence "Avoid eyes." to "Avoid pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas." Also add the sentences "This product should not be applied by children. Do not use on pregnant dogs."
