#### 1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This package is the first specific worm spray introduced into the Home and Garden market. It was developed to make it easy to kill worms quickly and maintain worm control.

#### 2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Mix 4 tablespoons in 3 gallons of water unless otherwise specified. Spray plants on both sides of foliage to the point of run off. Penetrate all dense foliage. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. Make new spray for each use. Follow directions listed below.

**ROSES, FLOWERS, ORNAMENTALS, TREES AND SHRUBS:** To kill Cutworms, Bagworms, Juniper and Mimosa Webworms, apply as directed above. For Mimosa Webworms apply as thorough foliar spray when adults first appear. Make two additional applications at 4-5 week intervals.

For Tent Caterpillars and Colonaster and Fall Webworms Mix 12 tablespoons in 3 gallons of water. Apply as a thorough foliage spray.

**LAWNS:** May be used on St. Augustine, Bermuda, Bent Bluegrass, Fescues, Meron and Dichondra. To kill Armyworms, Cutworms and Sod Webworms, mix 4 tablespoons in 3 gallons of water and apply to 125 sq. ft. Thoroughly water grass a few hours before applying. Repeat as necessary to maintain control.

**VEGETABLES:** Unless otherwise specified, mix 10 teaspoons (1 1/2 ozs.) in three gallons of water and cover approximately 1000 sq. ft. of garden. Thoroughly spray all plant parts. Apply when insects first appear. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. Do not feed treated forage to livestock.

**TOMATOES:** To kill Fall and Southern Armyworm. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

**CABBAGE, BROCCOLI AND CAULIFLOWER:** To kill Imported Cabbage worm. Generally, applications at 7-10 day intervals will be required. Do not apply to broccoli or cauliflower within 5 days of harvest or to cabbage within 7 days of harvest.

**COLLARDS, TURNIP TOPS, KALE, PARSLEY AND SWISS CHARD:** To kill Imported Cabbage worms, and Corn Earworms. Do not apply to collards, kale and turnip tops within 10 days of harvest or to parsley or Swiss Chard within 12 days of harvest.

**POTATOES:** To kill Southern Armyworms. Do not apply within 35 days of harvest.

**SWEET CORN:** To kill Corn Earworms. Mix 5 tablespoons (2 1/2 ozs.) in 3 gallons of water and apply to 1000 sq. ft. when silks first appear. Two to three repeat applications at 2-3 day intervals will be necessary. Corn may be picked immediately following last application.

#### 3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT

This new worm spray will quickly kill destructive worms found in your shrubs, gardens, lawns and vegetables, and give long lasting control.

**WARNING:** May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets or humans. Do not permit children or household pets to go onto sprayed grass or come in contact with foliage until spray has completely dried.

**DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.**

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated area may be killed. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of waste.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on crops. Protective information may be obtained from your Cooperative Agriculture Extension Service.

Do not reuse container for any purpose. Destroy empty container.
