

1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This new product was specifically developed to aid you in killing insects on your shade trees

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

To kill Aphids, Mites, Tent Caterpillars, Elm Leaf Beetles, Leaf Miners, European Pine Shoot Moth, Euonymus, Pine Needle and Juniper Scale (Crawlers), Mealy Bugs, Lacebugs, Cankerworms (inch worms), Willow Leaf Beetles, Japanese Beetle (adult) and Leafhoppers on OAK, PINES, BIRCH, ELM, HOLLY, MAGNOLIA, SYCAMORE, WILLOW AND MOST DECIDUOUS SHADE TREES. Mix 2 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water (or 8 ounces in 8 gallons of water for larger jobs). Apply thoroughly to all foliage surfaces when insects first appear. Repeat at 10-14 day intervals as necessary to maintain control.

NOTE: Do not use on ferns. Injury may occur on some species of Crassula and Canaerti Junipers. May be injurious to Chinese Elms, Japanese Maples, Japanese Barberry, Privet, Red Maple and Red Bud. Do not apply during periods of high humidity or severe drought.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT!

This new TREE SPRAY, used according to directions, will kill listed insects. This aids your trees to provide the shade for which they were intended.

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not take internally. Do not breathe fumes or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of feed and food-stuffs.

DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
