1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?
 This product gives you Azalea, Camellia and Gardenia Grower a spray that solves many disease problems in addition to insect problems.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?
 Shake well before using. Mix the recommended amount (shown in table below) per gallon of water, used.

| INSECT | AMOUNT TO USE | REMARKS |

| Aphids, Mites, Lace Bugs, Mealybugs, Thrips, Japanese Beetles, Tent Caterpillars, Bagworms & Leaf Miners | 5 Tablespoons | Apply thoroughly to all foliage surfaces where insects or the damage first appears. Repeat at 10-14 day intervals as needed to maintain control. For Florida Red Scale, apply when crawlers have settled on foliage. |
| Euonymus Scale, Azalea Scale, Florida Red Scale, Fletcher Scale, Tea Scale, Soft Scale & Oyster Shell Scale | 5 Tablespoons | |

| DISEASE | AMOUNT TO USE | REMARKS |
|--|---------------------------------|---|
| Azalea Petal Blight (Diploma), Camellia Flower or Petal Blight (Sclerotinia) | Mix 1 pint in 3-5 Gallons water | Apply to 25 sq. ft. Spray ground and surrounding area under plants. Repeat 4 weeks before bloom. Repeat at 3-4 week intervals through bloom period. |

NOTE Do not use on Ferns, Petunias, Viburnum, Lantana, and Crossbuds.

 When used as directed, this product controls the listed insects and diseases on Azaleas, Camellias and Gardenias.
