



1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This product is used for the control of nutgrass plants in lawns and ornamental plants. It is also used for spot treatment in lawns and ornamentals.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

This product is used with a spray applicator. Apply to the nutgrass plants in lawns and ornamentals. Nutgrass plants may periodically appear from nuts in the ground. Several applications during the growing season may be necessary to clean up the lawn.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT:

As directed, this product will kill nutgrass plants and prevent the growth of nutgrass plants. In some cases, nutgrass plants may temporarily increase in number.

**CAUTION:** Avoid contact with children, pets, and livestock. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands after use. Keep children and domestic animals off treated areas until this material has been washed off. Do not store near fertilizers. Seeds use fumes or fumes from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity.
