DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This product with special applicator package is designed for spot killing of Nutgrass plants in ornamental and flower beds, around shrubs, trees, patios, sidewalks and spot treatment in lawns.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

This bottle is an easy to use applicator. Apply 2 to 3 drops to the nutgrass plant. In 2 to 3 days plants begin to turn yellow and die. Nutgrass plants may periodically appear from nuts in the ground. Several applications during the growing season may be necessary to clean up an infested area.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT!

Used as directed, this product kills individual nutgrass plants. Digging or pulling of nutgrass plants sometime causes nutgrass to multiply rapidly.

STORAGE: Store in original container and place in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
