

1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

For control of insect pests on roses, ornamentals, shade trees, lawns and flowers.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

ROSES, ORNAMENTALS, SHADE TREES, FLOWERS: To kill Thrips, Japanese Beetles, Lace bugs, Leaf beetles, Leaf-miners, Flea beetles and Bagworms mix 2 teaspoons in 1 gallon of water. Using hose-on sprayer apply dilute spray to entire plant and ground around plant to the point of run-off. Repeat as necessary.

LAWNS: To kill Grubs, Sodwebworms (Lawn Moths), Ants, Chiggers, Fleas, Ticks, Earwigs, Boxelder bugs and Mosquitoes (adult) mix 4 tablespoons in 1 gallon of water. Using hose-on sprayer apply to 100 sq. ft. (10' x 10') of lawn area. When treating for surface pests, water lawn thoroughly before treatment and do not water again for 2-4 days after treatment. When treating for lawn root feeders, water heavily after treatment to wash spray into top few inches of soil.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT!

You may expect easy, economical insect control on ornamentals, flowers and lawns with the use of this product.

CAUTIONS: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Skin contact may be harmful. Avoid contact with skin. Wash face

and hands before eating or smoking. Take shower or bath after handling. Change to clean clothing daily.

DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

Food utensils such as tablespoons or measuring cups should not be used for food purposes after use with pesticides.

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
