

#### SPOT TREATMENT

Fire Ants: To aid in the control of fire ants in tawns and other outdoet recreation areas, apply 1¼ cups over, and 2 fL around, each fire ant mound. Immediately after application, water in thoroughly. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound area. Apply water gently to avoid disturbing ants. Use of high-pressure watering equipment may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness. Treat as necessary.

Note: For best results, apply in cool weather, 65-80° F, or in early morning or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.

Digger wasps: Apply one tablespoon of 1

, in and around each individual ground nest opening. Make the application about dusk when the wasps are not active.

next to the house foundation. Distribute granules uniformly, using a rate of 8 cc. per 100 sq. ft. of area (2 ft. x 50 ft.) treated. If necessary, replication at 3-week intervals.

### Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in original containsr in a cool, dry, while entitlated area inaccessible to children and domestic animply. Do not store near fertilizers, herbicides, seeds, food, or feed.
