Subject: Reregistration of Products Containing Disulfoton,
Alternate Source of Active and Additional Brand Name
Fertilome Azalea Evergreen Containing Systemic
EPA Registration No. 7401-235
Your Application Dated August 13, 1986
and February 11, 1987

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. The word "Disulfoton" should precede the chemical name in the ingredients statement.
2. Revise the first part of the precautionary statements as follows:

May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Do not breathe dust. Rapidly absorbed through the skin. Do not get on skin, in eyes or on clothing. Wash hands ... etc."
3. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment as follows:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
CAUTION

If Swallowed: Call a Physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water. Get medical attention. Wash clothing before reuse.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Get medical attention immediately.

4. Delete "Antidote: Atropine sulfate and/or 2-PAM" and replace with the following:

Note to Physician: Disulfoton is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

5. Place "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" above the precautionary statements paragraph.

6. Update the Environmental hazards statement by changing "by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to "when disposing of equipment wash waters."

The Alternate source of the active ingredient and the additional brand names, Hi-Yield Azalea, Camellia, Gardenia with Systemic and American Brand Azalea, Camellia, Gardenia with Systemic are acceptable and have been made a part of the record for this product.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

USE IT?
Using free measure cap on package, work required application (see feeding chart below) into top 1 inch of soil. Work deep because most evergreens have shallow root systems. Keep product 2 inches away from small shrub (or 4 inches on larger plants) and spread on soil out under widest spread of branches. Replace mulch. Immediately water.

NOTE: This product does not control chewing insects. This product should not be used on container grown plants. For container grown plants use fertilizer Arid Grow Select Plant Food.
