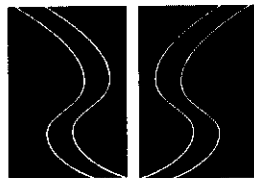

It also protects azaleas and evergreens against damaging sucking insects in one easy monthly application during the growing season.

APPLICATION OF PRODUCT

The cap on top of this package serves as a measuring cup equivalent to approximately 2 oz. After removing mulch, work required application (see feeding chart) into top 1 inch of soil. Do not cultivate deeply because most evergreens have shallow root systems. Keep product 2 inches away from small shrubs or tree trunks (3 to 4 inches on larger plants) and spread on soil under widest spread of branches. Replace mulch. Immediately water thoroughly.
