

1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

For easy control of powdery mildew on ornamentals, shrubs, flowers and shade trees.

For use on Roses, Azaleas, Camellias, Shade Trees, Crepe Myrtle, Fuchias, Lilac, Dahlias, Delphinium, Chrysanthemums, Snappedragons, Stocks, Sweet Peas and similar plants attacked by powdery mildew.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Mix 1 tablespoon in 1 gallon of water. Using hose-on or other sprayer, apply as a thorough cover spray to upper and lower leaf surfaces, stems and trunk and ground area around plants. Begin application when foliage or disease appears. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals as necessary.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT!

Beautiful ornamentals, shrubs, flowers and shade trees, free of destructive powdery mildew, are easily obtained with use of ferti-lome POWDERY MILDEW CONTROL.
