1. WHAT IS THIS PACKAGE FOR?

This product provides a convenient and effective way to kill Dandelions and Crabgrass. Also controls Chickweed, Plantains, Dallis Grass, Clover, Nutgrass, Johnson Grass.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?

Mow lawn 1 to 1½ inches high before treatment. New lawns should not be sprayed until after 3 mowings. Be sure soil is moist before application. Mix 3 teaspoons in 1 gallon of water. Spray on 100 sq.ft. (10'X 10') of lawn area. Spray thoroughly. For best results application should be made in spring through early fall when temperature is above 70° F. and weeds are young and actively growing. Spraying on a bright sunny day usually gives better results. Heavily infested lawns may require repeat application (10 to 14 days) to kill missed weeds. Do not apply within drip-line of desirable trees and shrubs. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in immediate vicinity. This rate will also kill Chickweed, Plantains, Dallis grass, Johnson grass, Nutgrass and Clovers. Do not apply with hose-end applicator.

NOTE: Do not use on St. Augustine, Carpet, Centipede, Bent-grass or Dichondra grass lawns.

3. HERE ARE THE RESULTS YOU MAY EXPECT!

Outstanding dandelion and crabgrass control in your lawn areas will be obtained with use of this product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container and place in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly and securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
