ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, and aquatic life stages of amphibians. Do not apply to water. ORNAMENTALS

Using a bulb or other type of commercially available duster apply to the following Flowers and Ornamentals before insects become numerous using sufficient dust to obtain light but thorough and even coverage of upper and lower sides of plant surfaces. Protect plants through the growing season by dusting at 7 to 14 day intervals and after heavy rains.

ROSES, FORSYTHIA, HYDRANGEA, PYRACANTHA, VIBURNUM, HOLLIES, BOXWOOD, AZALEAS, GLADIOLUS, DAHLIA, MARIGOLD, GERANIUM, PEONY, CHRYSANTHEMUM, DELPHINUM, RHODODENDRONS, ARBORVITAE, JUNIPERS, EUONYMUS, VIOLETS, PIERIS, JAPONICA AND LILAC – To control Aphids, Spider Mites, Leaf Miners, Thrips, White Flies, Japanese Beetles, Rose Leafhopper, Leafrollers, Fourlined Leaf Bug, Mealybugs, Tarnished Plant Bug, Lacebugs, Azalea Scale, Scurfy Scale, Euonymus Scale, Soft Brown Scale, Bagworms and Boxwood Leaf Miners.

CAUTION: Applications to ornamentals in bloom may cause injury to blooms. Do not apply to Hibiscus, Papaya, certain ferns including Boston, Maiden Hair and Pteris as well as some species of Crassula.
