Harmful is swallowed. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, and aquatic life states of amphibians. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. ROSES, FORSYTHIA, HYDRANGEA, PYRACANTHA, VIBURNUM, HOLLIES, BOXWOOD, AZALEAS, GLADIOLUS, DAHLIA, MARIGOLD, GERANIUM, PEONY, CHRYSANTHEMUM, DELPHINUM, RHODODENDRONS, ARBORVITAE, JUNIPERS, EUONYMUS, VIOLETS, PIERIS, JAPONICA AND LILAC – To control Aphids, Spider Mites, Leaf Miners, Thrips, White Flies, Japanese Beetles, Rose Leafhopper, Leafrollers, Fourlined Leaf Bug, Mealybugs, Tarnished Plant Bug, Lacebugs, Azalea Scale, Scurfy Scale, Euonymus Scale, Soft Brown Scale, Bagworms and Boxwood Leaf Miners.

CAUTION: Applications to ornamentals in bloom may cause injury to blooms. Do not apply to Hibiscus, Papaya, and certain ferns including Boston, Maiden Hair and Pteris as well as some species of Cressula.
