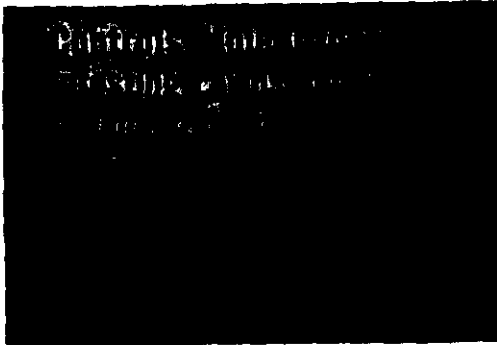

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**  
*Note to Physician:* Active ingredient is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

##### CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed. Do not take internally. Avoid eye contact. Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water and get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash thoroughly after handling. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use. Keep children and pets off treated area until this material is watered into soil and area is dry. DO NOT APPLY TO MANUS. Keep away from food, feedstuffs. Do not apply to vegetable crops.

##### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

##### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

Mole crickets damage lawns by feeding on grass roots and by forming mole-like tunnels that loosen the soil causing the grass to turn brown and die. They are found in newly planted areas and established turf as well. Feeding and tunneling occurs mostly at night.

Apply uniformly at the rate of 1 lb. per 200 sq. ft. to home lawns and all ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Immediately after application, thoroughly water the treated turf to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation. Re-treat as necessary.

Best results will occur if application is made late in the evening in September or August when the crickets are in the nymphal stages.

##### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Storage:** Keep away from food, feedstuffs, and domestic water supplies. Keep container closed.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collector.
