Mole Crickets damage lawns by feeding on grass roots and by forming mole like tunnels that loosen the soil causing the grass to turn brown and die. They are found in newly planted areas and established turf as well. Feeding and tunneling occurs mostly at night.

Apply uniformly on moist soil at the rate of 1 lb. per 200 sq. ft. to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power-operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Re-treat as necessary. Best results will occur if application is made late in the evening in June, July or August when the crickets are in the nymphal stages.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Keep away from food, feedstuffs, and domestic water supplies. Keep container closed.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
