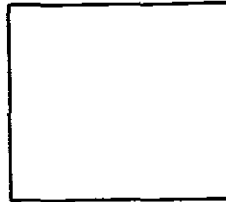

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with it's labeling.

This product is a Non-selective Herbicide that will eliminate undesirable vegetation in lawns, driveways, parking areas, between stepping stones and bricks, around fences, patios, flower beds, gardens, buildings, trees, and shrubs without harm to untreated plants and vegetation. One application will kill most weeds and grasses. See list on both sides of front panel of this label for a partial list of weeds and grasses controlled.

To prepare a spray solution, mix 8 fl. ozs. (1 cup) of this concentrate with 1 gallon of clean water.

Make a full coverage application being sure to thoroughly wet plant surfaces. Avoid cutting treated vegetation for at least 7 days. If certain hard to kill weeds and grasses are not completely killed in 14 to 21 days repeat application.

For spot treatment in lawns, flower beds, ornamental beds, around trees and shrubs, apply carefully to avoid contact with desirable vegetation. If spray or drift contacts desirable vegetation, wash off immediately with water.

For areas where renovation and reseeding is desired, make a thorough coverage of lawn area. Treated area should begin to turn brown within 7 days, then reseed or sod as desired.

*To prepare a refill for Hi-Yield Ready-To-Use Systemic Weed and Grass Killer, pour 3 1/2 ozs. of this product into the 1 Quart container and finish filling with clean water.

*To prepare a refill for Hi-Yield Systemic Vegetation Killer, pour 13 ozs. of this product into the 1 Gallon container and finish filling with clean water.
