DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT FOR?
Use this product to effectively kill unwanted weeds and grasses. See the front panel for a partial list of weeds and grasses controlled.

2. HOW DO YOU USE IT?
Mix with water and apply uniformly to the soil with a broadcast or type sprayer or with a hose-on sprayer. Weed & Grass Control will kill both emerged and dormant weeds. Rain or watering within 2 or 3 days of application increases effectiveness of emerged weeds. However, for dormant weeds, rain or watering is necessary within 7 to 10 days.

ST. AUGUSTINE & CENTIPEDE GRASS: Grass Control may be applied to established grasses during both the dormant and the active growing periods. Usually obtained in the early Spring of dormant or have not emerged.

DORMANT BERMUDAGRASS: Apply to dormant grasses. Applications to Bermudagrass during the active growing period may cause injury. Follow rates on table below.

DICHONDRA, MONEYWORT: The best control is obtained by making an application in early April or May. Do not apply to growing Bermudagrass.

Applications for Spurweed or Florida Betony should be made before the appearance of the other weeds listed. However, applications for Premergent Weed & Grass Control will give the best control of tender weeds or just prior to weed emergence.

FLORIDA BETONY: This weed emerges in late February would give the best control in late February.

SPURWEED: The best control of spurweed is obtained when spurweed has emerged (December or January).

RATE OF APPLICATION: Determine the rate of application on the chart below. Avoid over-application. Shake contents well before mixing.
