VEGETABLES - GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

BEANS Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

CABBAGE BROCCOLI CAULIFLOWER Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

CARROTS Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

CELERY Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

CORN Sweet Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

LETTUCE Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

PEACHES - APRICOTS

STRAWBERRIES

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Store in original container. Do not use if container is damaged. Dispose of unused material in accordance with local regulations.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

TURF GRASSES

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

NOTE

SHRUBS & FLOWERS - GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

AZALEAS - CAMELLIAS

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

CARNATIONS - CHRYSANTHEMUMS - HOLLYHOCKS - SNAP DRAGONS

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

GLADIOLUS

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

ROSES

Apply to foliage of plants in the garden or lawn. Use a fine spray nozzle. Spray thoroughly, covering both sides of leaves. Repeat every 7 to 14 days. Do not spray during rain or when plants are wet.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
